Subject:- Consideration order in compliance to Hon'ble CAT order dated 12.11.2021 passed in OA No. 1700/2021 titled Faizan Ahmad Zargar & Anr Vs UT of J&K.

1. Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide Notification No. 05-PSC (DR-P) of 2021 dated 11.05.2021 advertised 91 posts of Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies for being filed up from eligible candidates, and
2. Whereas, the last date for filing of online application complete in all respects along with the requisite fee was fixed as 16.06.2021, and
3. Whereas, the applicants claim to have applied against the supra notification but have failed to pay the requisite fee allegedly due to network failure because of which their application forms were not accepted, and.
4. Whereas, the applicants agitated their grievance before the Hon'ble CAT by filing an OA no. 1700/2021 and the Hon'ble Tribunal while considering the case has vide its order dated 12.11.2021 directed as under:-

"Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, we dispose of the O.A. with direction to the respondents to consider the grievance of the applicants, if any pending with the PSC and take a decision on the same in accordance with law by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 10 days from today under intimation to the applicants."

5. Whereas, while considering the claim of the applicants, it has been found as reported by the NIC as well as the Bank that the payment was not initiated. Infact it has been found that as many as 11,434 candidates have applied during the last two days without any hindrances, and
6. Whereas, even assuming but not admitting that there was some difficulty in the deposit of the requisite fee but the applicants did not approach the help lines notified for the purpose within due time, and

7. Whereas, the applicants submitted a representation when the cut of date was already over, and
8. Whereas, the cut of date cannot be further extended neither can the applicants be allowed to deposit the fee at this late stage because such a course would not only hamper the present selection process but would also set a bad precedent for other selection processes as well, and
9. Whereas, a cut of date is specifically notified with the purpose that the Commission would make the arrangements and proceed ahead with the selection process and complete the same within a time bound manner, however in case the candidates like the applicants who have themselves been negligent would be allowed to deposit their fee after the cut of dates then all the arrangements would get disturbed and the selections processes would be open ended perpetually, and

Now, therefore, in compliance to Hon'ble CAT order dated 12.11.2021 passed in passed in OA No. 1700/2021 titled Faizan Ahmad Zargar & Anr Vs UT of J&K, and the facts stated above, the claim of the applicants has been considered and found devoid of any merit and therefore rejected.
