It is hereby notified for information of the general public that following amendments shall be substituted in the existing Rule 44(i) & 44 (ii) of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021:-

Selection of Consultant in Health & Medical Education Department and Lecturer/Assistant Professor in Health & Medical Education Department respectively.

(i) Assessment for Selection against the posts of Consultants in the Health & Medical Education Department shall be based on the following principles:
