Whereas, the Higher Education Department vide letter No. Coll/Coord/Apptt/AP/2017 dated 18.10.2017 referred 10 posts [OM: 07, RBA: 01, SC:01, & ST: 01] of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Bio-Technology for selection of suitable candidates; and

Whereas, the posts were advertised vide Notification No.10-PSC(DR-P) of 2017 dated 27.10.2017 and 333 applications were received. Upon scrutiny of the documents of the candidates, 30 eligible candidates were called for interview which was conducted on 20.09.2021 & 21.09.2021 with the assistance of Experts from outside UT; and


Whereas, the provisional select list was issued vide Notification No.84-PSC(DR-S) of 2021, dated 03.11.2021 wherein 10 candidates were selected provisionally under various Categories, with the stipulation that objections, if any, be submitted to the Commission within five days from the issuance of the provisional select list for examination/disposal and that no claim, whatsoever, shall be entertained after five days from the date of issuance of Notification; and

In response to the above Notification, 04 representations have been received in the Commission as per the details below and are, accordingly, disposed off with the clarification/remarks as indicated:-

1.	Shivanjali Kotwal	The candidate claimed that:- i. The points for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) has not been awarded. ii. Out of 3 Publications, only two have been considered. iii. Points for Paper Presentations have also not been awarded	I. As per Rule 51, points are prescribed for NET + JRF, which means JRF is to be qualified and awarded by UGC/CSIR on the basis of securing higher merit in the NET. II. & III. Assessment of special attributes viz Publications/Research and Paper Presentations is the domain of the Experts on the Interview Board, which has accepted only two publications. The representation, as such, merits no consideration.
2.	Tsering Angmo	The candidate wants to recheck the special attributes of Mr. Javed Iqbal.	The representation is not specific as such cannot be considered. However, the assessment made by the Experts on the Board is in disputeable. The representation, as such, merits no consideration

Peer Abdul Haseeb Shah	The candidate claimed that his Post Doctorate and Teaching experience have not been added.	<p>The candidate has claimed benefit of Post-Ph.D research and teaching experience which he has acquired in the Department of Bio-resources, University of Kashmir from 28TH October, 2015 as DST INSPIRE Faculty. The document has been issued by the Coordinator PG Programme in Bio-resources, Department of Botany University of Kashmir vide No.F(Per-F) 2017/KU/BR/17 dated 31.10.2017 mentioning therein that Peer Abdul Haseeb Shah is involved in teaching various courses to the post-graduate students of Bioresources apart from pursuing his own research programme.</p> <p>As per Rule 51 of J&K Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 1980 amended from time to time, teaching experience at the level of the post applied for i.e. Assistant Professor or immediately above or below in the relevant subject is to be considered for accord of weightage. The above document neither mentions the post against which he has worked nor clearly indicates that the applicant was teaching the subject of Bio-Technology, instead it reveals that "he is involved in teaching various courses". Therefore, this document has not been considered as teaching experience.</p> <p>With regard to Post-doc research experience, no such document was attached with the application form. However, the candidate has submitted document with his application dated 15.11.2021, issued by the Dean School of Biological Sciences, University of Kashmir, Srinagar vide No.F(Inspire-Faculty) DSBS/KU/21 dated 6.09.2021, wherein he has been shown working as an INSPIRE Faculty Fellow performing his research related activities. This document is related to the same period for which he has claimed teaching experience.</p> <p>Again, no particular research programme with kind of research undertaken has been mentioned in</p>

			the certificate and the document has been issued after cut off date i.e. 31.12.2017. The representation, as such, merits no consideration.
