Subject: Select List for the posts of Lecturer 10+2 (Computer Sciences) in School Education Department.

Notification No. 01 – PSC (DR-S) of 2021

Dated: 04.01.2021

Whereas, the School Education Department referred 09 posts (OM:05, RBA:02, SC:01 & ST:01) of Lecturer in the discipline of Computer Sciences to the Public Service Commission for being filled up from amongst the suitable candidates; and

Whereas, the Commission notified these posts vide Notification No. 06-PSC of 2008 dated 23.05.2008; and

Whereas, in response to the above notification, **851** applications were received; and

Whereas, the written test of the candidates for selection was conducted on 03.04.2011. The result of the written test was declared vide Notification No. No.PSC/Exam/11/50 dated 09.04.2011 in pursuance of Rule 32(a) of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 and Rule 40 of the J&K Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 1980 as amended from time to time and 120 candidates were declared to have qualified the written test and called for interview; and

Whereas, Ms. Kunzas Dolma secured 61 marks in the Screening Test. The Commission rejected the candidature of Ms. Kunzas Dolma on the grounds that her qualification (MCM) is not relevant/equivalent for the post. Aggrieved by the rejection of candidature, Ms. Kunzas Dolma filed a writ petition No.1949/2011 seeking quashing of the communication whereby her candidature for the post of Lecturer in Computer Science was rejected on the ground that the qualification possessed by her was not Post Graduation in Computer Science; and

Whereas, the interviews of the shortlisted candidates were conducted at Srinagar on 10.09.2011 with the assistance of an Expert from outside the State; and

Whereas, the writ petition No.1949/2011 was disposed of by the Hon'ble High Court with a direction to the School Education Department to take decision with regard to the eligibility of the writ petitioner keeping in view a communication dated 14.07.2017 from the Jammu University to the School Education Department regarding the qualification possessed by the petitioner.

Whereas, the J&K PSC filed an LPA in the Hon'ble High Court with a plea that **“there is not provision for equivalence of qualifications in the Rules and that similarly situated candidates were not considered by the Commission. The equivalence was required to be considered by the Competent Authority.”**; and

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court dismissed the LPA filed by the Commission on 09.08.2019.

Whereas, in compliance to the decision of the Hon'ble High Court the interview of the petitioner was initially conducted on 16.11.2019. The selection process initiated by the erstwhile Commission remained inconclusive owing to enactment of J&K Reorganisation Act, 2019, and the consequent communication from the General Administration Department dated 21.11.2019. Therefore, the actions taken by the erstwhile Commission after the appointed date viz. 31.10.2019 have been reviewed by the present Commission and it was decided in the 5th Commission Meeting held on 07.09.2020 to conduct the interviews afresh; and

Whereas, the interview of the candidate was conducted at Jammu by the reconstituted Commission on 05.11.2020.

Now, therefore, on the basis of the performance in the interview and other related parameters, **Ms. Kunzes Dolma D/O Tsering Norbo R/O D 10 Tsering Norbo** who has secured **50.28** points is recommended for selection against the available post under **ST Category**.

Note:-

1. The Commission reserves the right to have certificates/documents of the candidate verified, if it is at any stage found expedient to do so. The Selection of the candidate is purely provisional and is subject to the outcome of writ petitions pending before any competent Court of law.
2. The select list is provisional. Any objection may be submitted to the Commission within five days for examination and disposal. No claim will be entertained after five days from the date of issuance of Notification.
