Revised Eligibility Notice for the post of Lecturer, Bio-Chemistry Government Medical College Jammu in Health & Medical Education Department notified vide Notification No. 03-PSC (DR-P) of 2019 dated 19.03.2019.

Whereas, the Health & Medical Education Department vide communication NO.ME/GAZ/187/2014 dated 12.02.2019/21.01.2019, among others, referred 01 post of Lecturer Bio-Chemistry, under OM, for Government Medical College, Jammu; and

Whereas, the post was notified vide Notification No-03 –PSC (DR-P)of 2019 dated 19.03.2019, under item No. 10 and against which 21 application forms were received; and

Whereas, in the meantime, the Health & Medical Education Department vide communication No. ME-GAZ-109/2019 dated 15.10.2019 clarified that the general notes  $2^{nd}$  &  $3^{rd}$  appended at the end of the Jammu & Kashmir Medical Education (Gazetted) Services Recruitment Rules notified vide SRO 517 of 1979 dated  $19^{th}$  September, 1979 define the ratio of non-medical teachers for non-clinical departments. The notes  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  appended to these rules reads as under:-

"Except in the case of Non-Clinical Departments of Anatomy, Physiology, Pharmacology, Bio-Chemistry and Micro-Biology, where non-medical Teachers to the extent of 30% may be appointed to posts other than the head of the departments (who must necessarily hold a recognized medical qualification), all other teachers must possess the following basic qualifications in addition to the Post graduate qualification mentioned in the above schedule, namely:-

Recognized qualifications included in the First or second Schedule; or Part-II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualification) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holder of Educational qualifications mentioned in Part-II of the third Schedule should fulfil the conditions stipulated in sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

However, a Non-Medical Teacher in Bio-Chemistry in a Medical College with Doctorate Qualifications in Bio-Chemistry may also be considered for the post of the Head of the Department of Bio Chemistry.

Non-Medical M.Sc qualification also be considered as sufficient for the junior teaching posts in the subject (like Lecturers/Demonstrators). For promotion to higher teaching posts they must acquire the Ph.D degree in the subject"

Whereas, the Health & Medical Education Department further intimated that out of the seven (07) faculty members in the discipline of Bio-Chemistry at present in Government Medical College, Jammu, three (03) are from Medical side and Four (04) are from non-Medical side. This would indicate that the non-Medical faculty members are in the ratio of more than 30% of the prescribed upper limit. Accordingly, the Department has intimated that the next candidate to be selected shall necessarily come from Medical side; and

Whereas, the Health & Medical Education Department while forwarding the indent vide letter No. ME/Gaz/187/2014 dated 12.02.2019 had not mentioned specifically the above position and the Notice dated 01.07.2019 was issued strictly as per the indent forwarded by the Department; and

Whereas, in view of the communication No. ME-GAZ-109/2019 dated 15.10.2019 from the Health & Medical Education Department, the selection of Lecturer Bio-Chemistry in Government Medical College, Jammu has to be restricted to the candidates having Medical background only; and

Whereas, the application forms submitted by the candidates in response to the advertisement. Notice dated 01.07.2019, were scrutinized on the basis of clarification conveyed by the Health and Medical Education Department and found that that out of 20 candidates applied for the post of Lecturer Biochemistry, 14 have been found ineligible as they have non-clinical background and 06 have been found provisionally eligible as they have Clinical background.

Now, therefore, keeping in view of the above position, the names of the candidates who have been found eligible/in-eligible for the post of Lecturer-Biochemistry in Government Medical Colleges are hereby notified for information:
