Mr. Azhar-ul-Amin, leaned Standing Counsel for Public Service

Commission on the basis of communication sent to him has
submitted as under:

"1. The recommendations in respect of promotion of CMOs and equivalent as Deputy Director, Health Services stands furnished to the Administrative Department on 15.05.2014.

2. The Minutes of DPC for regularization of consultants as Senior Consultants of Health and Family Welfare Department which was held on 15.05.2014 under the Chairmanship of Shri K. B. Jandial, Member I&K Public Service Commission have been signed by all Members of the DPC and recommendations of the Commission have been sent to the Administrative Department on 09.06.2014. However, consideration in respect

of Dr. Mohammad Ashraf Bhat has been kept in sealed cover in pursuance of Art. 110-A of J&K CSRs. As the doctor is presently under suspension.

3. The proposal regarding promotion of Medical Officers as CMP and equivalent of Health and Family Welfare Department was as per schedule discussed in the DPC on 03.06.2014. The DPC has considered only those cases who were found complete in all respects and minutes are being formulated and will be got signed by the Members of the DPC within weeks time."

Mr. Kawoosa, learned Senior Additional Advocate General

states that the orders shall now be issued within ten days.

Accordingly, time for implementation of the judgment is extended upto 20.06.2014. The follow up action would also be taken up in accordance with the directions of this Court.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.

In view of the above, the Contempt Petition nos. 123/2013 and 13/2014 would also not survive. Rule discharged.

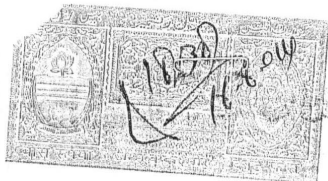
