1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner, apprehending that his case for promotion to the post of C.T.O/E.T.O might not be considered for extraneous consideration.
2. Objections have been filed by respondent Nos. 1 and 2, stating therein that the apprehension is misconceived to the extent that earlier the petitioner was not considered for placement as Incharge C.T.O/E.T.O on account of the fact that he had not qualified the departmental examination. Subsequently, it is stated that the petitioner having qualified the same, his case would also be recommended for consideration by the DPC for promotion as and when the same takes place.
3. In view of the stand taken by the official respondents, Mr. Jalali, learned Sr. Advocate

appearing for the petitioner, submits that he would feel satisfied if his case was considered by the DPC as and when the same is convened for purposes of promotion to the post of C.T.O/E.T.O along with all other eligible candidates.

4. Be that as it may, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that the case of the petitioner be also considered for promotion along with all other eligible candidates to the post of C.T.O/E.T.O as and when exercise is initiated in that regard.

5. Connected CMA is also disposed of accordingly.
