Subject: - Unfair means cases during the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination 2011.

Whereas, J&K Public Service Commission vide notification No: PSC/Exm-11/120 dated: 04.10.2011 invited applications from eligible candidates, desirous of appearing in Combined Competitive (Main) Examination 2011, in accordance with the provisions laid down in SRO 387 of 2008 and J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, among others the below mentioned candidates also submitted their application forms for appearing in the above said examination, consequently, Roll No's. 1201183, 0301171 were allotted to them; and

Whereas the Combined Competitive (Main) Examination, 2011 is being held w.e.f 15.02.2012 at different centers of Jammu & Srinagar; and

Whereas, before the commencement of examination, vide important notice dated: 11.01.2012 and 04.02.2012 the candidates were cautioned against bringing any unwanted material in the examination centre and also on the commencement of examination and on all subsequent days of examination, prior warnings are being issued by the Supervisors against resorting to any type of unfairmeans covered in J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, during the course of examination these candidates were found resorting to various types of unfair means detected by the supervisory staff, details whereof are given as under:-

02.	Anupum Sharma	0301171	Zoology-I	21-02-2012	The candidate had incriminating material written on his Admit Card which was seized from him during the course of examination.

Whereas, the incriminating material found in their possession falls within the definition

of unfair means under Rule 20 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination)

Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, they are prima facie found guilty of resorting to unfairmeans and are liable to

punishment under Rule 25 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations), Rules,

2005; and

Whereas the cases were placed before the Controller of Examinations in terms of Rule

23 of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 for

consideration who is satisfied that prima facie case of unfairmeans exists and as such has

decided to serve a show cause notice upon these candidates as to why action under Rule, 25 of

Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 be not

taken against them.

Now, therefore, before imposing appropriate punishment under rules upon the above

said candidates, they are directed to show cause within 05 days from the date of issuance of

this notice as to why action in erms of Rule 20 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of

Examinations) Rules, 2005 be not taken against them. Failure to show cause within the

stipulated time, action as warranted under Rule, 25 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct

of Examinations) Rules, 2005 shall follow, without any further notice.

However, in case they want to appear in person or want to produce any evidence or

record their statements, they may appear before the Secretary & Controller of Examination, J&K

Public Service Commission, Resham Ghar Colony, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu on 05.03.2012 at 11.00
