It is for the information of all the concerned candidates that the J&K Combined Competitive (Preliminary) Examination, 2012 shall be held on **05.08.2012** (Sunday) as already notified/reiterated from time to time.

The Admit Cards have already been dispatched to the candidates. However, they may also download the same from the Commission's website [www.jkpsc.nic.in](http://www.jkpsc.nic.in).

The eligible candidates who, fail to receive the Admit Cards upto or are not able to download the same, may approach the Commission office at Srinagar/Jammu on. 01.08.2012 upto 04:00 PM, where the Admit Cards shall be provided to such eligible candidates free of charges.

Further, candidates may ensure that at the time of examination;

- i. He/she has recorded the roll number as well as the series correctly. The response sheet of the candidate, who had recorded wrong roll number or series will not be evaluated.
- ii. Before you mark the answers, fill the Question Booklet No., series, roll number in the answer sheet correctly and darken the corresponding oval as per the instructions.
- iii. Concerned invigilator has rightly recorded the series on the back side of the response sheet.
- iv. The candidate should use only **blue/black ball point pen** preferably for marking the ovals in the OMR response sheet.
- v. Oval has been completely darkened.
- vi. Only one oval is darkened. If the candidates darken more than one oval the answer will be treated as wrong.
- vii. Any stray mark(s) recorded by the candidate on the answer sheet shall be treated as unfair means.
- viii. The candidate reports to the examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of examination.
- ix. No candidate will be allowed to enter **Examination Hall** after 10 minutes of the commencement of examination.
- x. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall until the expiry of full time.

- xi. No candidate shall bring Mobile Phone or any other electronic gadget within the premises of examination centre.
- xii. Candidates are in their own interest advised to locate their examination centre in advance, before actual day of examination, to avoid any inconvenience on the day of examination.
- xiii. In case any candidate feels that any discrepancy existing in the test booklet in any question (s) or the Responses, a written representation explaining the details of such alleged discrepancy, be submitted within three days, indicating the Question No. (s) and the Test Booklet Series, in which the discrepancy is alleged. **Representation not received within time shall not be entertained at all.**

Furthermore, concerned **Invigilators** deployed by the Supervisors for such duty may ensure that the above instructions issued to the candidates have been followed by the candidates strictly. Any laxity on the part of invigilation staff shall be viewed with concern.
