Sub:- Complaints against the eligibility of Sh. Sami-Ullah Khan S/o Sh. Moulvi Abdul Hanan for appearing in Revenue Service (Executive) Departmental Examination.

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission conducts various Departmental and Competitive Examinations including the Revenue Service (Executive) Departmental Examination; and

Whereas, the Revenue Service (Executive) Departmental Examination 2012 (Session-I) is being held w.e.f. 23.04.2012 for which 377 candidates have submitted their application forms; and

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission is regularly receiving complaints from various quarters against the eligibility of one candidate namely Sami-Ullah Khan S/O Sh. Moulvi Abdul Hanan who was a candidate of Revenue Service (Executive) Departmental Examination 2011 (Session-II); and

Whereas, the received complaints are pressing that the above said candidate has already exhausted all four allowed chances for said examination and therefore is/was not eligible for 5th chance; and

Whereas, to put the records straight about the candidate viz-a-viz all availed chances, the factual position is given below for general information;

Whereas, the above details amply make it clear that the candidate namely Sh. Sami-Ullah Khan has availed only four chances barring Revenue Service (Executive) Departmental Examination Jan-June, 2005 which was exempted from being calculated as a chance vide Commission decision of 14th meeting dated: 05.08.2005, applicable to all candidates who had appeared in the said examination; and

Whereas, despite availing all the allowed chances, the candidate has not fully qualified the said examination.

Now, therefore, it is for information of all concerned that all complaints on this account have been found without any substance and are disposed off by Public Service Commission accordingly.
