PRESS RELEASE

The J&K Public Service Commission has announced the result of J&K Combined Competitive Examination, 2011.

The General Administration Department referred 142 vacancies which included Junior KAS (117), J&K Accounts (Gazetted) Service (16) and J&K Police (Gazetted) Service (09) to the J&K Public Service Commission on 31.05.2011. The Commission notified the vacancies on 20.06.2011. Preliminary Examination was conducted on 25.09.2011. A total of 21,414 candidates appeared in the Preliminary Examination. A total of 3555 candidates qualified for the Mains (Written) Examination which was conducted from 15.02.2012 to 10.03.2012.

A total of 503 candidates qualified for the interview. The interviews were conducted from 21.05.2012 to 02.07.2012 at Srinagar and the results have been declared on 06.07.2012. The whole exercise was completed in 12 months and 16 days.

Mohit Raina has topped the merit list followed by Pooja Rasgotra and Anissa Nabi in second and third positions. Nine out of first ten positions have been bagged by women candidates.
