**Subject:** Unfair means cases framed during the Revenue Services (Executive) Departmental Examination, Session May-June 2013.

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide notification No. PSC/EXAM/2012/180 dated: 31.12.2012 invited applications from eligible candidates desirous of appearing in the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue Services (Executive) Departmental Examination, Session May-June, 2013 in accordance with the provisions laid down vide SRO 339 dated 07.10.2003 read with J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination) Rules 2005; and

Whereas, among others you also submitted your application form for appearing in the above said examination, consequently, Roll No's. 103 was allotted to you; and

Whereas, the Revenue Services (Executive) Departmental Examination, Session May-June, 2013 was held w.e.f 29.05.2013 to 06.06.2013 at Public Service Commission Office Complex, Resham Ghar Colony, Bakhshi Nagar Jammu and S.P. Higher Secondary School, M.A. Road, Srinagar and

Whereas, on the first day of commencement of examination and on all subsequent days of examination, prior warnings were issued by the supervisors against resorting to any type of unfair means covered in J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct Of Examination) Rules 2005; and

Whereas, during the course of examination you were found resorting to unfair means as reported by the supervisory staff, details whereof given as under:-

01.	Gh. Mohd. Wani	103	V	03.06.213	Caught with a small hand written chit, when the invigilator tried to seize the same, the candidate tore it and then swallowed.

Whereas, you are prima facie found guilty of resorting to unfair means and are liable to punishment under Rule 25 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination) Rules, 2005.

Now, therefore, before imposing appropriate punishments under rules upon you, you are directed to Show Cause within 10 days from the date of issuance of this notice as to why action in terms of above quoted rule may not be taken against you. Failure to show cause within the stipulated time, action as warranted under rules shall follow, without any further notice.

However, in case you wants to appear in person or wants to produce any evidence or record your statement, you may appear before the Secretary & Controller of Examination on 30/08/2013 at 11:00 A.M for the purpose.
