Subject: Unfair means cases framed during the Secretariat Assistants Training Course / Foundation Course Departmental Examination, Session February-2012.

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide notification No.PSC/EXAM/2012/01 dated 02/01/2012 invited applications from eligible candidates, desirous for appearing in Secretariat Assistants Training Course Departmental Examination, in accordance with the provisions laid down in Govt. Order No. 4-ARI of 1998 dated 27.02.1998 / Foundation Course Departmental Examination, in accordance with the provisions laid down in Govt. Order No. 238-GAD of 2010 dated 15.02.2010 read with J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct Of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, among others the below mentioned candidates also submitted their application forms for appearing in the above said examination, consequently, Roll No's. 06, 56, 58, 62, 163, 260, 288, 274, 301, 339, 140, 116, 146 and 267 were allotted to them; and

Whereas, the Secretariat Assistants Training Course / Foundation Course Departmental Examination, was held w.e.f. 06.02.2012 to 13.02.2012 at different centers at Jammu & Srinagar; and

Whereas, on the first day of commencement of examination and on all subsequent days of examination, prior warnings were issued by the supervisors against resorting to any type of unfair means covered in J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct Of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, during the course of examination these candidates were found resorting to various types of unfair means detected by the supervisory staff, details whereof are given as under:-

Whereas, the incriminating material found in their possessions falls within the definition of unfair means under Rule 20 of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct Of Examinations) Rules,2005; and

Whereas the cases were placed before the Controller of Examinations in terms of Rule 23 of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 for

consideration who is satisfied that prima facie case of unfair means exists and as such has decided to serve a show cause notice upon these candidates as to why action under Rule, 25 of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 be not taken against them.

Now, therefore, before imposing appropriate punishments under rules upon these candidates, they are directed to individually Show Cause within 10 days from the date of issuance of this notice as to why action in terms of above quoted rule be not taken against them. Failure to show cause within the stipulated time, action as warranted under rules shall follow, without any further notice.

However, in case any of the candidates wants to appear in person or wants to produce any evidence or record his / her statement, he / she may appear before the Secretary & Controller of Examinations J&K Public Service Commission, Resham Ghar Colony, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu on 05-03-2012 at 11 A.M for the purpose.
