- 1) Whereas, the School Education Department vide their communication No.Edu/V/4/2008 dated 16.03.2016 among others referred 10 (Ten) posts of Lecturer (10+2) Biotechnology [OM-07, RBA-02 & ST-01] to the J&K Public Service Commission for filling up from amongst the eligible/suitable candidates; and
- 2) Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission in pursuance of the reference of the vacancies by the School Education Department, vide Notification No.09-PSC (DR-P) of 2016 dated 19.03.2016, invited online applications from the permanent residents of Jammu & Kashmir possessing the prescribed qualification; and
- 3) Whereas, in response, a total number of 1094 applications forms have been received by the Commission without calling for the hard copies of the testimonials on the premise that only eligible candidates shall apply; and
- 4) Whereas, the written test of the candidates for selection was conducted on 01.01.2017 in which 927 candidates appeared. The result of the written test was declared vide Notification No. PSC/Exam/2017/51 dated: 27.09.2017 in pursuance of Rule 32(a) of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005 and Rule 40 of the J&K Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 1980 as amended from time to time and 47 candidates were declared to have qualified the written test and called for interview; and
- 5) Whereas, among others, Mr. Rohit Pandit bearing Roll No.5400697 also qualified for viva-voce test; and
- 6) Whereas, the interview of the shortlisted candidates was conducted w.e.f. 10.10.2017 to 11.10.2017 with the assistance of experts from outside the State; and
- 7) Whereas, Mr. Rohit Pandit appeared before the Interview Board on 11.10.2017; and
- 8) Whereas, during the course of scrutiny of documents, it was found that Sh. Rohit Pandit has the basic qualification i.e. P.G. in Environmental Biotechnology; and

9) Whereas, he was allowed to appear provisionally before the interview board pending clarification about determination of eligibility viz. "Environmental Biotechnology"; and

10) Whereas, the case of Sh. Rohit Pandit was placed before the Commission on 13.10.2017; and

12) Whereas, the Commission after threadbare discussion found that Sh. Rohit Pandit does not fulfill the eligibility criteria as per Recruitment Rules of having basic qualification in the relevant subject viz. Biotechnology vis-à-vis in terms of having no provision of "equivalence" in the Recruitment Rules; and

13) Whereas, in view of the above position, the Commission held Sh. Rohit Pandit ineligible viz. eligibility in Recruitment Rules.

Now, therefore, the candidature of Sh. Rohit Pandit is hereby rejected on being found as ineligible in terms of relevant Recruitment Rules.
