Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide notification No.**PSC/EXAM-2011/139 dated 10/12/2011** and **PSC/EXAM-12/49 dated. 19.03.2012** invited applications from eligible candidates, desirous for appearing in KCS (Judicial) Competitive Examination 2012, in accordance with the provisions laid down in **SRO NO 05 dated 04.01.1968** and J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, among others, the below mentioned candidates also submitted their application forms for appearing in the above said examination, consequently, Roll No's. 2100053, 2100857, 2101515 & 2101749 were allotted to them; and

Whereas, the KCS (Judicial) Competitive Examination 2012, was held w.e.f. 07.07.2012 to 19.07.2012 at different centers at Jammu & Srinagar; and

Whereas, during the course of examination 03 unfair means cases were registered by the Supervisors of different centers; and

Whereas, upon Scrutiny of Answer Scripts, it was found that one more candidate bearing Roll No 2101749 has recorded peculiar remarks and has also disclosed his identity by recording his name on the answer book of Paper III(Compulsory), the act of the candidate falls under the purview of Rule 20(f) of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, the accused candidates were served with Show Cause notices through press and by post asking them to explain their position and, if desired, appear in person before the Controller of Examinations J&K Public Service Commission in support of their cause; and

Whereas, out of 4 involved candidates only 03 candidates preferred their replies to show cause notices served to them and also recorded their statements before the Controller of Examinations, while as the 4th candidate did not respond; and

Whereas, the cases along with all allied material were placed before the Committee on Unfair means which after examining the seized incriminating material, Supervisor's report and the explanations preferred by the accused candidates formulated recommendations in respect of each case for consideration and decision of the Commission; and

Whereas, after considering the cases in light of the recommendations of the Committee on Unfair means the Commission approved award of punishments to the involved candidates as shown in remarks column against each below:-
