Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide notification No.**PSC/EXAM/2012/74** dated **10/05/2012** invited applications from eligible candidates, desirous for appearing in Secretariat Assistants Course Departmental Examination / Foundation Course Departmental Examination 2012 (Session II), in accordance with the provisions laid down in **Govt. Order No. 4-ARI of 1998 dated 27.02.1998** / **Govt. Order No. 238-GAD of 2010 dated 15.02.2010** and J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, among others the below mentioned candidates also submitted their application forms for appearing in the above said examination, consequently, Roll No's. 06, 09, 11, 53, 69, 92, 134, 195, 203, 209, 210 & 279 respectively were allotted to them; and

Whereas, the Secretariat Assistants Course / Foundation Course Departmental Examination 2012 (Session II), was held w.e.f. 20.07.2012 to 26.07.2012 at different centers at Jammu & Srinagar; and

Whereas, during the course of examination 11 unfair means cases were registered by the Supervisors of different centers; and

Whereas, upon Scrutiny of Answer Scripts, it was found that one more candidate bearing Roll No 279 had made an appeal in Paper V, the act of the candidate falls under the purview of Rule 20(f) of J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Rules, 2005; and

Whereas, the accused candidates were served with Show Cause notices through press and by post asking them to explain their position and, if desired, appear in person before the Controller of Examinations J&K Public Service Commission in support of their cause; and

Whereas, out of 12 involved candidates only 08 candidates preferred their replies to show cause notices served to them and also recorded their statements before the Controller of Examinations, while as the 04 candidates did not respond; and

Whereas, the cases along with all allied material were placed before the Committee on Unfair means which after examining the seized incriminating material, Supervisor's report and the explanations preferred by the accused candidates formulated recommendations in respect of each case for consideration and decision of the Commission; and

Whereas, after considering the cases in light of the recommendations of the Committee on Unfair means the Commission approved award of punishments to the involved candidates as shown in remarks column against each below:-
