Subject:- Selection for the post of Lecturer-I Civil Engineering in Polytechnic, Jammu.

Order No :- 202 - PSC of 2012

Dated :- 27 -06- 2012

Whereas, vide this office Notification No. 28-PSC (DR-P) of 2012 dated: 25-04-2012, among other posts, 11 (eleven) posts of Lecturer-I Civil Engineering with category-wise break-up as -OM =07, RBA=01, SC=01, ST=01, & SLC=01, were notified;

Whereas, in response to the said Notification the Commission received 264 Application Forms for the referred to posts;

Whereas, as per Rule 40 of J&K Public Service Commission (Business and Procedure) Rules, 1980, the candidates were shortlisted in the ratio prescribed under rules in respect of each category on the basis of the percentage of marks at Graduation level i.e. Basic Qualification prescribed for the posts;

Whereas, vide this office notice dated 21-06-2012, provisional cut off merit separately for each category was notified for information of the concerned candidates with the following proviso:-

“ However, in case they feel that they do possess marks/points higher than the last candidate shortlisted for interview, they may represent before the Commission with proof of being eligible within a weeks time positively , lest it shall be deemed that they have nothing to say in this regard.”;

Whereas, in response to the said notice, two candidates namely Shahida Rafiq and Tabish Jehan Quereshi, claiming the possession of M. Tech. Degrees approached the Commission with the request that their M. Tech. qualification be given weightage for shortlisting them for the interview;

Whereas, the documentary evidence produced by the candidates was scrutinized and the claim on this score was found correct ;

Whereas, on enquiry it got revealed that during the course of scanning of the Application Forms of these candidates, the scanner could not read and record their PG qualification and consequently no weightage was allowed to the candidates on this

account leading to their ultimate inadvertent exclusion from the list of shortlisted candidates ;

Whereas, another candidate namely Ahmad Wani had not filled relevant ovals in OMR form with respect to Max marks and Marks obtained (but had only filled relevant ovals for percentage of marks) and consequently the programme developed for the purpose could not calculate the percentage. This omission remained undetected till the candidate represented before the Commission with the fact that he has higher percentage than the last candidate shortlisted for interview.

Now, therefore, after proper scrutiny of all the representations submitted by the candidates in response to the above mentioned notice, a revised provisional cut off merit has been worked out which is as under :-

In the above backdrop, the following three candidates who were earlier left out inadvertently are held provisionally eligible and shall be called for interview as and when conducted for the post:-

1. Shahida Rafiq {6477/8000=80.96%} ---72.87 (Out of 90) +4 (PG qualification)= 76.87 (Merit)
2. Tabish Jehan Quereshi {6379/8000=79.74%}----71.76 (Out of 90) +4 (PG Qualification)=75.76 (Merit)
3. Ahmad Wani { 9.603/10=96.03%} ----- 86.43 (out of 90)(Merit)

Consequent upon the above, the candidature of the following three candidates who were earlier provisionally shortlisted and figured at the bottom of list are hereby excluded from the said list as they do not make the grade for the revised cut off percentage worked out in consequence of the above.

1. Tariq Ahmad Kuchey 8.276/10 = 82.76% ----- 74.48 (out of 90) merit
2. Itret Hussain 6617/8000 =82.71% -----74.44 (Out of 90) merit
3. Sunit Sharma 8.27/10 =82.70%----- 74.43 (Out of 90) merit
