Subject: Provisional Select List for the post of Assistant Professor, Mathematics, in Higher Education Department – disposal of representations thereof.

Whereas, the Higher Education Department, vide letter No.HE/Coll/Coord/ Apptt/A.P/2021 dated 05.07.2021 and No. HED-GAZ/85/2022-04 dated 13.04.2022, among others, referred (**seven**) **07** posts (OM=04, RBA=01, SC=01, ST=01) of Assistant Professor Mathematics, in Higher Education Department, for selection; and,

Whereas, the posts were advertised vide Notification No. 06-PSC (DR-P) of 2023 dated 01.03.2023; and,

Whereas, the Higher Education Department, vide letter No. HED-GAZ/85/2022-04 dated 24.03.2023, among others, again referred 10 posts (OM=03, RBA=01, SC=01, ST=01, PSP=01, ALC/IB=01, SLC=01, EWS=01) of Assistant Professor, Mathematics, in Higher Education Department; and,

Whereas, these posts were advertised, vide Notification No. 17-PSC (DR-P) of 2023 dated 15.05.2023; and,

Whereas, the written test was conducted on 05.11.2023, and the result thereof was declared vide Notification No. PSC/Exam/S/2024/08 dated 01.04.2024. The viva voce of candidates who qualified the Written Test in both the Notification was conducted on 5th & 6th of December, 2024 with the assistance of Experts; and,

Whereas, the provisional Select List was issued vide Notification No.40-PSC(DR-S) of 2024 dated 06.12.2024 and subject to objections, if any, which were to be received within five days; and,

Whereas, two (02) representations have been received from



Whereas, the objections raised in the representations and their consideration is given hereunder:

01	Mr. Hanan Akhtar	In Provisional Select List issued vide Notification No. 40-PSC(DR-S) of 2024 dated 06.12.2024, shows 1.50 marks given to me for teaching experience, whereas 02 marks are	As per check sheet prepared at the time of interview and dully signed by the candidate, he has submitted two experience certificates, viz, (i) letter

		due to him for having teaching experience of four years-all of level 10, and each more than 06 (six) months.	No.F (Exp.Cert-NC)Adm/TW/KU/23 dated 14.03.2023 issued by University of Kashmir, for the period 10.04.2010 to 31.12.2010 & 15.04.2013 to 31.01.2014 (ii) letter No. GDCWB/2024-25/1119 for the period 08.05.2009 to 28.02.2010 for which 1.50 points have been awarded to him, as admissible under rules. No document, whatsoever is entertained after the Interview process is over.
02	Mr. Naseer Wani	<p>Two candidates, Ms. Devia Narraina and Mr. Manish Kumar, reportedly husband and wife, were assigned consecutive roll numbers in both examinations, despite the fact that the posts were advertised separately and at different times.</p> <p>Furthermore, it has been observed that both candidates secured top marks in the written examinations for both posts but were unable to secure good scores in the interviews. This sequential roll number allocation and their performance pattern raise concerns about the transparency of the recruitment process, considering that these examinations were conducted independently. We also note that the Provisional Selection List for the post of Assistant Professor (Mathematics) in GCET was released vide Notification No. 93-PSC (DR-S) of 2023 Dated: 18.11.2023, while the Provisional Selection List for Degree Colleges (HED) was released vide Notification No. 40-PSC (DR-S) of 2024 Dated: 06.12.2024.</p>	The roll numbers are assigned randomly on the basis of the randomization done by the Computer Programme. The candidates got consecutive roll numbers in both the examinations because the same computer program is used to generate roll numbers for all Higher Education posts/examinations. There is no human intervention in the generation of attendance rolls/admit cards, it's all done by the Computer programs.

Now, therefore, the above representations are disposed off, being devoid of any merit and hence stand rejected.
