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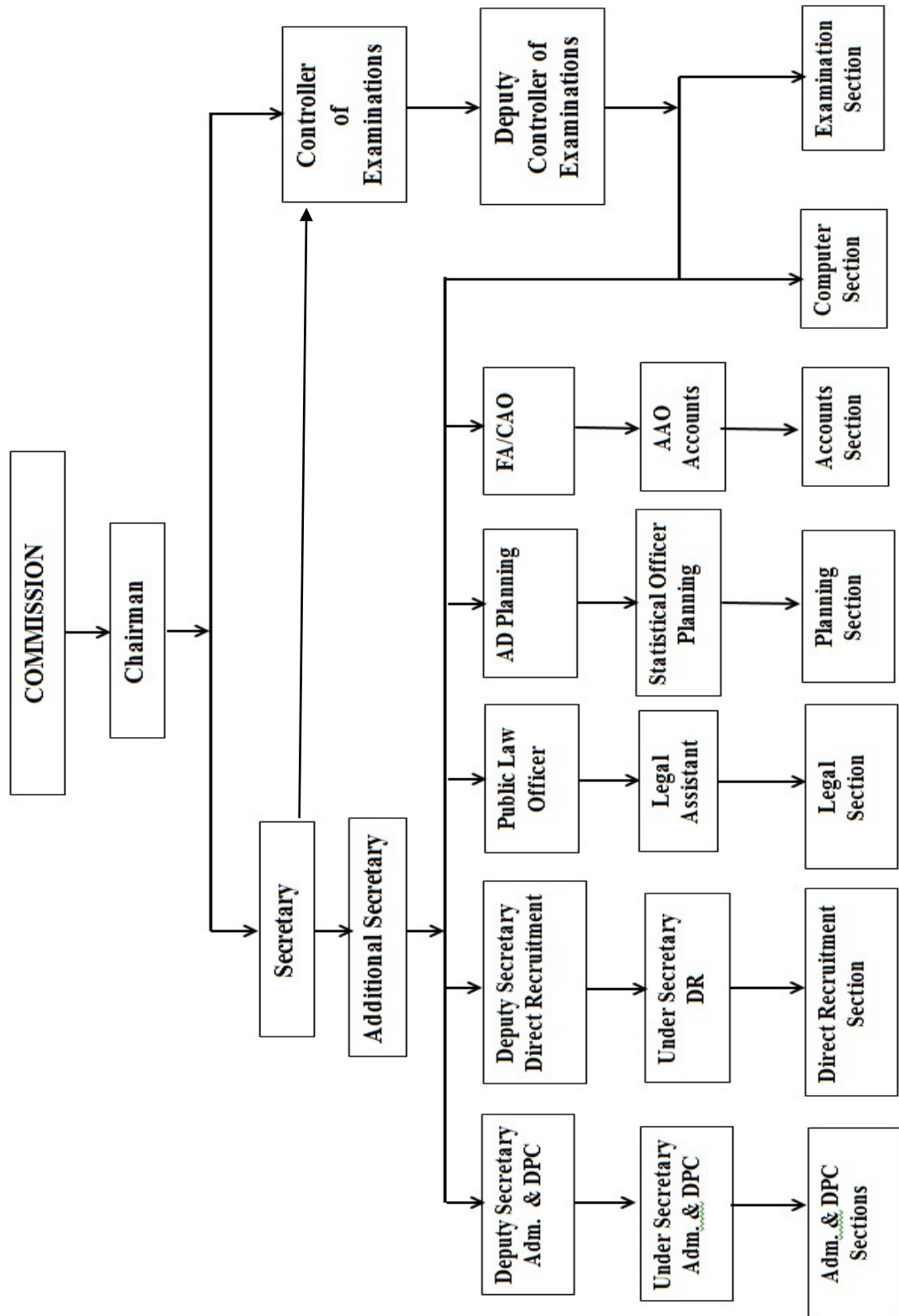

2. Profiles of the Hon'ble Chairman and Hon'ble Members of the Commission

Chairman



Mr. Arun Kumar Choudhary

Born at village Mahisi of district Saharsa Bihar, he did most of his schooling in Patna. He graduated from University of Delhi with B.SC (Hons) in Physics and later on completed his master degree in Public Administration from Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU).

He served in National Bank for Agriculture & Rural Development (NABARD) as Assistant Development Officer for three-and-a-half years before joining Indian Police Services (IPS) in September, 1991.

As an IPS Officer he served in various capacities in Jammu & Kashmir including as Sub Divisional Police Officer in Uri & R.S Pura, District Supdt of police in Leh & Udhampur, Commandant in J&K Armed Police and Indian Reserved Police and held various important positions in Police Headquarters. He also worked as Managing Director, J&K Police Housing Corporation, Additional Director General of Police, Armed (APHQ), Additional Director General of Police, Co-ordination (PHQ) and Special Director General of police, Crime. He was on deputation to United Nations for its peace keeping mission in Kosovo. He served in Government of India, on deputation, for 8 years, during which period he also worked as a Diplomat (First Secretary) in the High Commission of India, United Kingdom (London) for around three-and-a-half years.

As recognition of his contribution to the public service, he has received a number of medals and awards including President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service, President's Police Medal for Meritorious Service, J&K Police Medal for Meritorious Service and United Nations Peace keeping Medal etc.

He was appointed as Chairman of J&K Public Service Commission where he took oath of office on 29th February, 2024.

Hon'ble Members



Dr. RAJIV SINGH, HON'BLE MEMBER

Dr. Rajiv Singh began his professional journey in 1993 as a faculty member at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, SKUAST-Jammu, located at the R.S. Pura campus. After earning his PhD from PAU, Ludhiana, in 2002, he advanced through academic ranks to become a Professor in 2010. In 2011, he completed a post-doctoral training program at North Carolina State University, Raleigh (USA).

Over the years, Dr Singh has held several significant administrative and academic positions. He served as the Head of the Division of Veterinary Medicine for 12 years and led the Instructional Farms. He also served as the Coordinator of the University Examination Cell, Managing Director of the Experiential Learning Unit, and a member of the Monitoring and Evaluation Committee for the Internship Program. Additionally, he has led the Veterinary Emergency Response Unit and has served as a member of statutory bodies, including the university's academic, research, and extension committees.

Before his current role with the JKPSC, Dr Singh actively participated in national-level selection committees for academic and research appointments. He played a key role in curriculum development as part of the ICAR syllabus finalization committee and served as an examiner for graduate, postgraduate, and PhD examinations. He also participated in setting question papers for university entrance and ICAR-NET examinations, and served as a resource person for the HADP's 'Dairy Development in J&K' project."

As a researcher, Dr Singh has made substantial contributions to veterinary medicine. His academic record includes the publication of 150 research papers, 8 books, 22 book chapters, and 8 practical manuals. He has delivered 20 invited or lead lectures and organized over 30 conferences, workshops, seminars, and training programs. As a mentor, he has guided 2 PhD and 9 master's students as a major advisor, and co-guided 14 doctoral and 47 master's candidates. He has successfully led 10 research projects funded by national agencies such as DST, DBT, and ICAR, in addition to 7 projects supported by state and university bodies.

In recognition of his outstanding contributions, Dr Singh has received several prestigious honours. These include fellowships from the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (2018), the National Academy of Dairy Science (2014), and the Academy of Sciences for Animal Welfare (2017). He was also awarded the Star Scientist Award by his university (2021), the Best Division Award (2022), and the Young Scientist Award by the J&KCST (2004), in addition to multiple honours for his conference presentations.

In June 2024, Dr. Rajiv was nominated as a member of J&K Public Service Commission.



Mr. YASHPAL KOTWAL, HON'BLE MEMBER

Mr. Yashpal Kotwal, had completed his degree in Law from University of Jammu in 1989 and started practice as advocate in Jammu and Kashmir High Court at Jammu in January 1990. He was appointed as Munsif (Civil Judge, Junior Division) in 1997 and promoted as Sub-Judge (Civil Judge, Senior Division) in 2002.

Mr. Kotwal was further promoted/appointed as District Judge in 2011 and remained posted in various courts including Presiding Officer Fast Track Court, Special Judge Anti-Corruption, CBI cases for Kashmir Division at Srinagar.

Mr. Kotwal has also served as Principal District Judge Kishtwar, Reasi and Samba. He got retired from Judicial Services on 31st January 2024.

In June 2024, Mr. Yashpal Kotwal was appointed as a Member of J&K Public Service Commission.



Mr. TARIQ AHMAD ZARGAR, HON'BLE MEMBER

Born and brought up at Bomai Sopore, Baramulla, Mr. Tariq Ahmad Zargar did his initial schooling in the same village and completed the graduation in science subject from Government Degree College, Sopore. He did his master's degree in Zoology from Aligarh Muslim University.

In the year 1999, he cracked the Kashmir Administrative Service (KAS) examination and held several key administrative positions, noteworthy of which are:

- Block Development Officer, Rural Development Department.
- Additional Deputy Commissioner Bandipora.
- Additional Mission Director, J&K Rural Levelihood Mission.
- Mission Director, RashtriyaUchchatarShikshaAbhiyan (RUSA).
- Deputy Commissioner, Poonch
- Director, Information and PR.
- Director, Hospitality and Protocol, J&K.
- Special Secretary, Industries and Commerce Department.
- Director, Rural Development, Kashmir.
- Director, Handicrafts, Kashmir.
- Secretary in the Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj.

Apart from initiatives towards good governance and public outreach programmes taken by him while holding key administrative positions, he , in the capacity of Additional Mission Director, significantly contributed in successfully grounding the Rural Levelihoods Mission (UMEED) Scheme in Jammu and Kashmir, which was appreciated by the concerned Ministry and the State Government. His work and efforts towards establishing Cluster University Srinagar and Cluster University Jammu, the first cluster universities established in the Country, under RUSA, has been one of the significant achievement attributed to him.



Mr. Asaf Mehmood Sagar, HON'BLE MEMBER

Born in 1966 at village Shahdara Sharief in District Rajouri. Mr. Asaf Mehmood Sagar graduated from Government Degree College Rajouri and completed Master's Degree in Botany from University of Jammu in 1989. He started his service career as a lecturer in Botany in the J&K Education Department in 1990. In 1992 he cleared Indian Forest Service (IFS) exam and joined Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA) on 01.01.1993 as IFS probationer. He completed his foundation course at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNA) in 1995. He worked as Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) in District Poonch, Doda and Baramulla from 1997 to 2004. In 2004 after getting elevated, he was posted as Senior Agrostologist in Fodder/Grass production Wing of the J&K Forest Department. From 2008 to 2009 he worked as General Manager I/C R&D Wing of J&K State Forest Corporation.

Subsequently, he was given field postings as Conservator of Forest Jammu West Circle, Regional Wildlife Warden I/C Jammu Region, Chief Conservator of Forests I/C Jammu Province, Chief Conservator of Forests I/C Settlement and Demarcation Wing of J&K Forest Department, Director J&K Forest Protection Force, Director J&K Forest Research Institute, Director Soil and Water Conservation Department and Chief Executive Officer J&K CAMPA. Finally he joined as Hon'ble Member J&K Public Service Commission in July 2024 after tendering technical resignation from Indian Forest Service as Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

3. Brief History & Functions of the Commission

The J&K Public Service Commission was constituted in the year 1957 under Section 128 of the Constitution of Jammu & Kashmir, to discharge the functions specified in Section 133 of the Constitution. However, the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir was rendered infructuous on 05 August 2019 by an order signed by the President of India. The Commission has now been functioning under Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

Provisions for the J&K Public Service Commission

Article 93 of the J&K Re-organisation Act 2019 envisages that:

- I. The Public Service Commission for the existing state of Jammu and Kashmir shall, on and from the appointed date, be the Public Service Commission for the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- II The Union Public Service Commission, with the approval of the President, shall serve the needs of the Union Territory of Ladakh.

III The Persons holding office immediately before the appointed day as the Chairman or other Members of the Public Service Commission for the existing State of Jammu and Kashmir shall, as from the appointed day, be the Chairman or, as the case may be, the other Member of the Public Service Commission for the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

IV Every person who becomes the Chairman or other Member of the Public Service Commission for the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir on the appointed day under section (3) shall be entitled to receive from the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, conditions of service not less favourable than those which he was entitled to under the provisions applicable to him.

V The Report of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission as to the work done by the Commission in respect of any period before the appointed day shall be presented to the Lieutenant Governor of Union Territory of Jammu

and Kashmir who shall, on receipt of such report, cause a copy thereof together with memorandum explaining as far as possible, as respects the cases, if any, where the advice of the Commission was not accepted, the reasons for such non-acceptance to be laid before the legislature of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION

1. Conducts Competitive examinations and interviews for appointments to various Gazetted Services of the UT of J&K.

(2) The Commission is to be consulted:-

- I. On all matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and Civil posts.
- II. On the principles to be followed in making appointments and promotions within the civil services.
- III. Framing and amendment of Recruitment Rules for various Services and posts under the UT of J&K.
- IV. Disciplinary cases relating to different Civil Services.
- V. On any matter referred by the Lt. Governor of the UT of J&K.

4. Highlights

1. **Regularization/Promotion:** The Commission, during the year under report, cleared the promotion/regularization proposals of 886 officers belonging to different departments. There has been an increase in the efficiency of making regularizations/promotions.

To clear the decades-old pending regularization/promotion cases, the Hon'ble Chairman had demi-officially advised all the Administrative Secretaries to get the deficiencies completed in time time-bound manner. This resulted in a large number of promotion/regularization cases having come to the Commission and its disposal.

2. **Direct Recruitment:**

The Commission made recommendations to the Govt. for appointments and promotions for 1607 posts, which included the selection and recommendation of 721 candidates for appointment and promotion of 886

officers in various Departments (Annexure 01 & 05).

3. **DIGITISATION:** The J&K Public Service Commission, in conformity with the guidelines of the Digital India Mission, has switched over its office functioning to the E-Office mode to ensure efficiency and accountability.

4. **NEW RECRUITMENT POLICY:** The J&K Public Service Commission has adopted 100% written-examination-based recruitment to ensure transparency in the overall recruitment process.

5. **FAST TRACK RECRUITMENTS:** In respect of the prestigious UT Level Combined Competitive Examination, Junior Judges in Civil Judiciary etc. the J&K PSC fast-tracked the selection and has adopted the system of declaring the result on the last day of the conduct of the interviews consecutively for the last four years, viz. 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 .

6. **Inclusion of Transgender:** The J&K PSC, on the recommendation of the National Human Rights Commission, has implemented progressive reforms like inclusion of the option for Transgender in all the application forms and nomination of a Grievance Redressal Officer (GRO) for disabled persons.

7. **On-Screen Evaluation:**

The Commission has switched over to the "On-Screen Evaluation" system to ensure error-free evaluation and to avoid delay in the selection process. Also, the Commission uploads on a regular basis all the relevant information on the official website. Moreover, in the premises of the Commission, including the Secrecy, Examination/evaluation Section(s) are under 24x7 CCTV Surveillance for ensuring transparency of work culture and to safeguard the sensitive records of the Commission.

8. **One Time Registration (OTR)**

A prestigious project of the Commission, i.e. one one-time registration (OTR) has also been taken up for implementation. The

candidate, once registered with the Commission, as the name suggests, would not be required to register again and again. He would simply be required to upload the information with regard to his qualification/ higher qualification as and when he/ she upgrades his/her qualification. Depending upon acquiring of higher qualification his/her eligibility for the said posts.

9. The Commission conducted 53 screening tests/written tests/ Preliminary examination, and 01 Mains (*Appendix – 11*).

10. Six departmental Examinations were conducted during the year under report, viz, Accounts Clerk Course (old/New), Subordinate Accounts Course-I (old/New) & Subordinate Accounts Course-II (old/New), Secretariat Assistant Course, Foundation Course and Secretariat Assistant Training Course, wherein 4011 candidates appeared (*Annexure 12*).

11. A total of 880 posts of various categories were advertised in different Departments for Recruitment (*Appendix 15*).

12. The Commission received indents for 974 posts from 08 Departments for selections (*Appendix-10*).

Fig. 1. Applications received for various advertised posts over past five years.

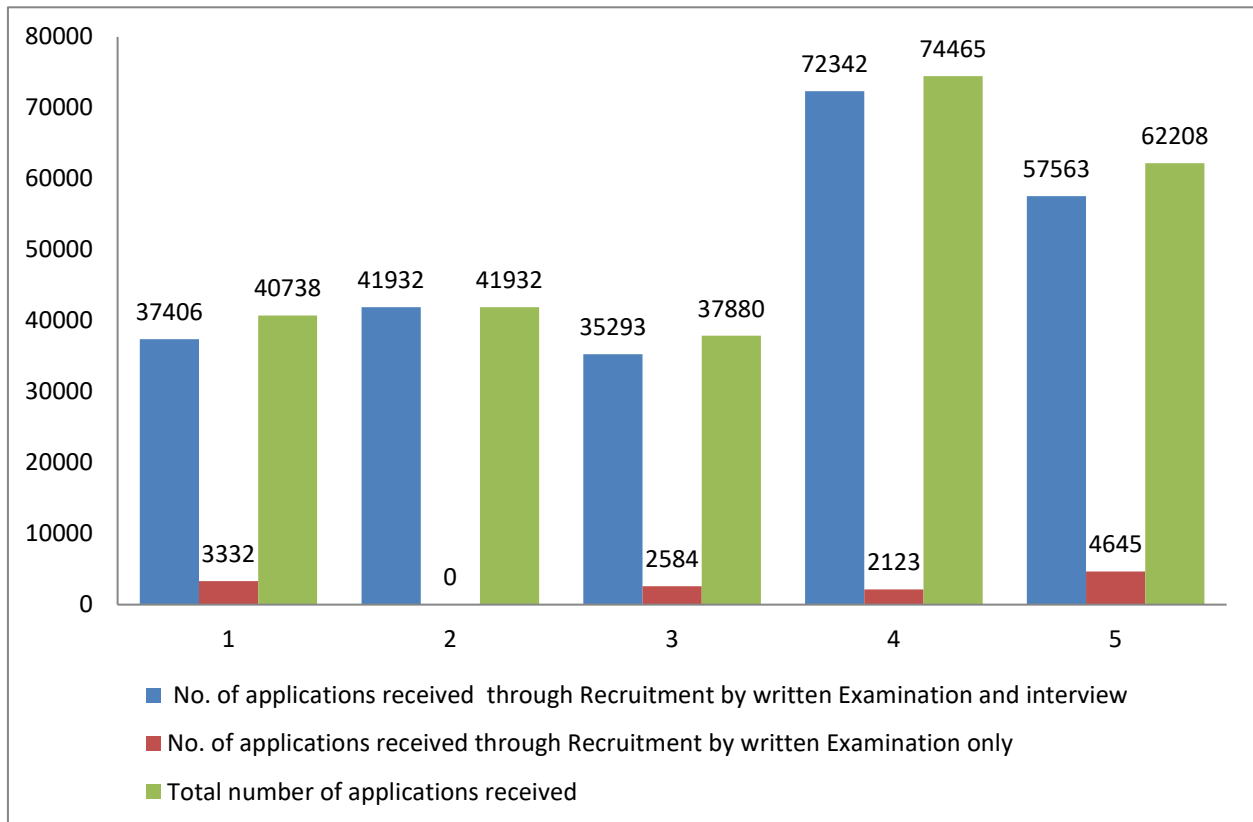


Fig. 2. Total number of Candidates recommended/selected for various posts over the past five years.

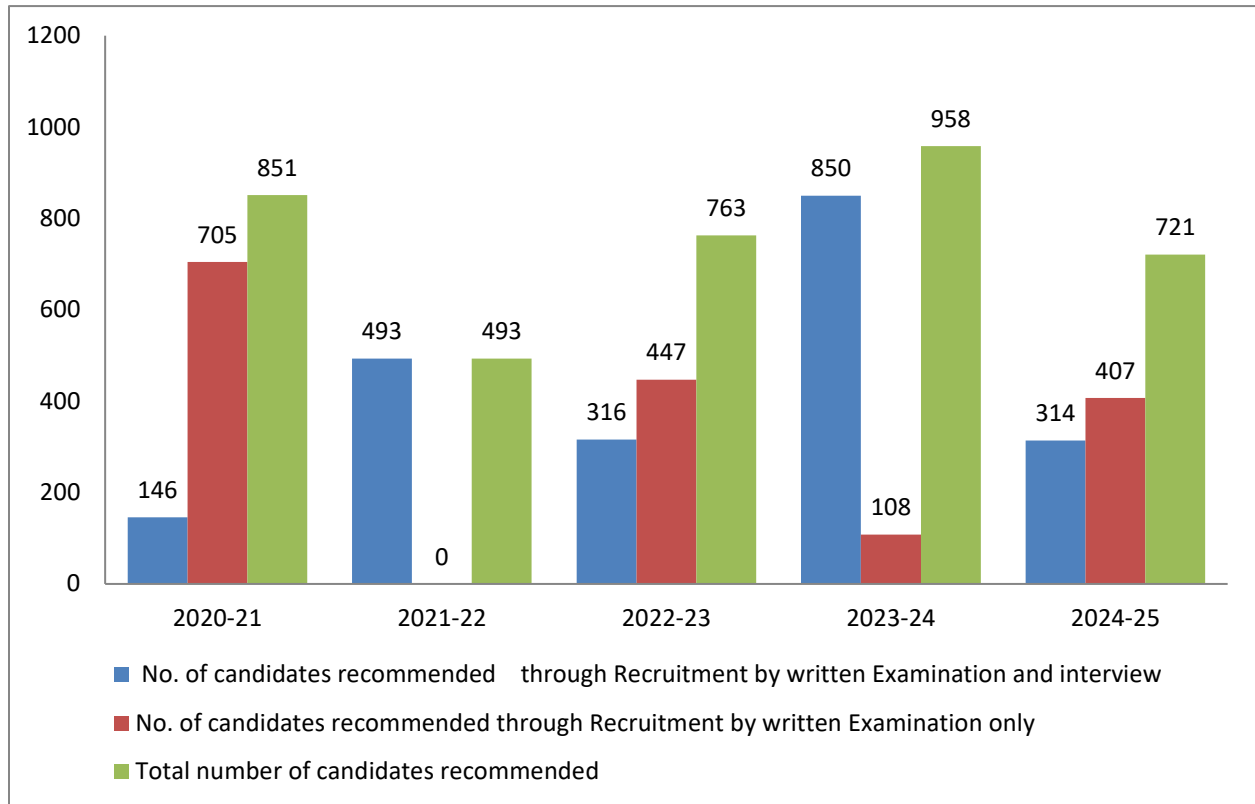

Fig. 3 Departmental Examinations conducted along with candidates appeared over past 10 years period.

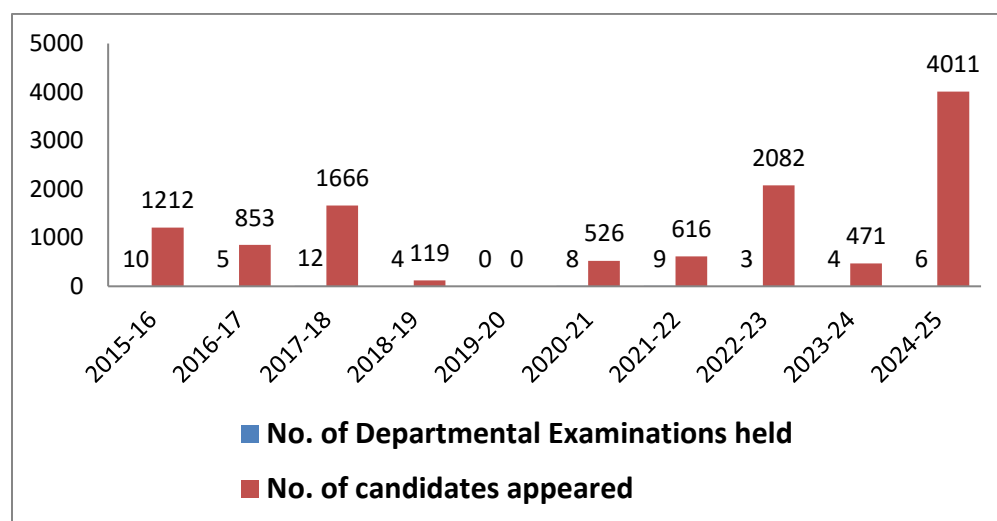

Fig. 4 Details of promotion proposals received

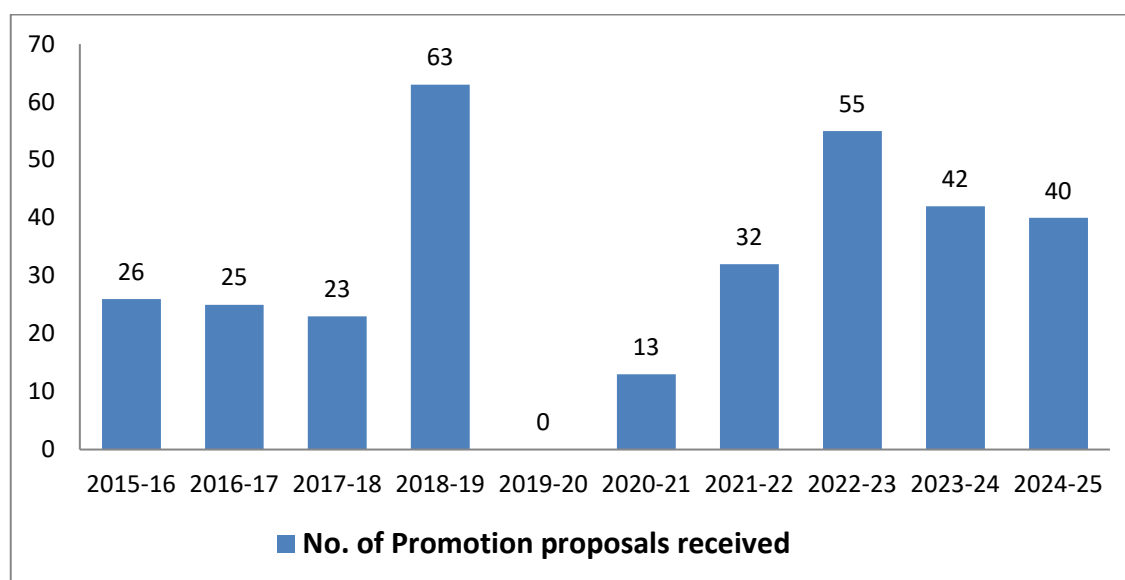


Fig. 5 Detail of candidates recommended through Departmental promotion Committee.

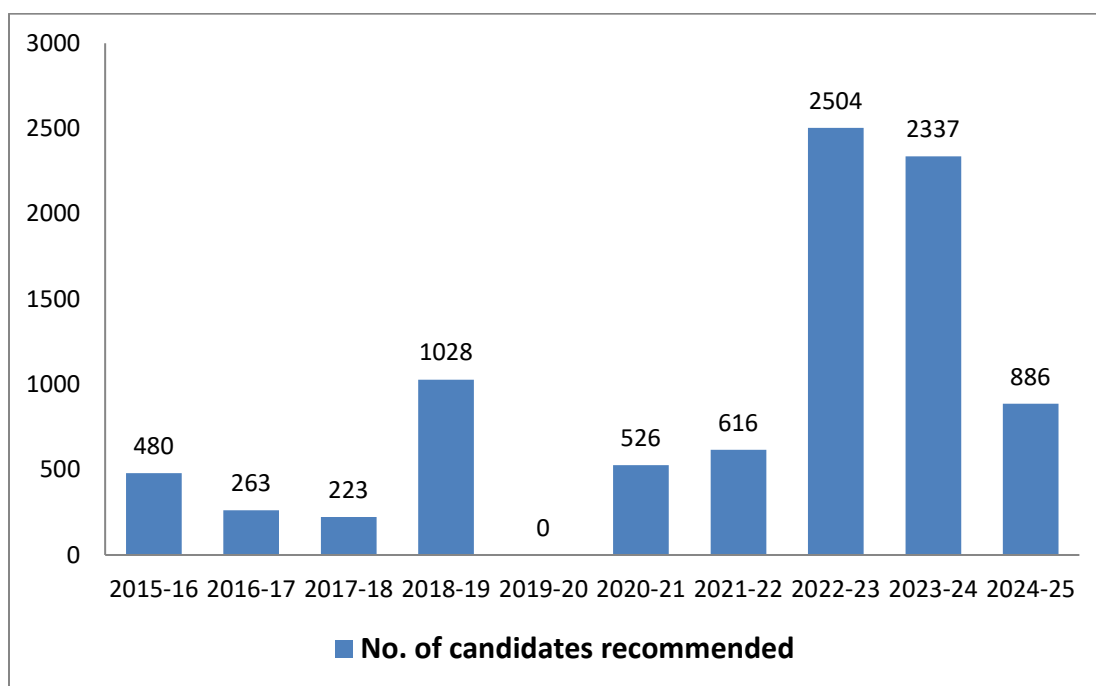
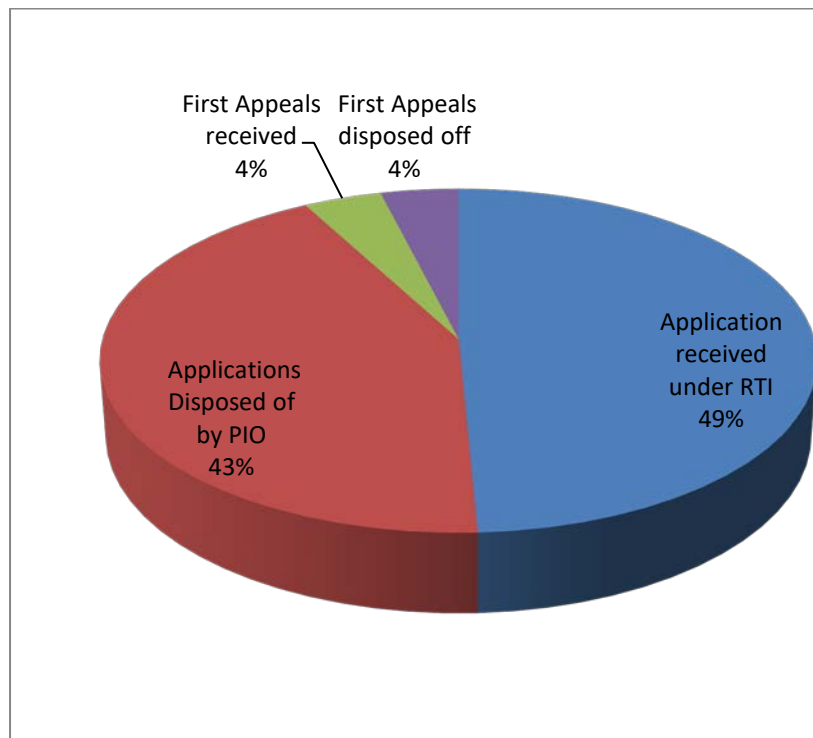

6. Direct Recruitment

Direct recruitment was made for filling up of vacancies referred prior to issuance of the SRO:-438, dated:-11-12-2015, as per the relevant recruitment rules in vogue, i.e. by direct interview after short listing the candidates by conducting screening tests wherever necessary. The process of recruitment by interview started with the receipt of a formal requisition from the indenting department. This was followed by the advertisement of the posts, receipt of applications, determination of eligibility and short listing by holding screening tests where the number of applicants exceeded 350 for the posts up to 100 and finally the holding of interviews. The selection process culminated in the making of recommendations by the Commission to the Government for the appointment of suitable candidates. Direct recruitment for the posts referred after 11-12-2015 was made strictly as per the above-mentioned SRO.

A) Recruitment by Examination only

During the year **2024-25**, under the report, the Commission made 407 recommendations **under recruitment by written Examination only**. The category-wise break-up of 407 candidates recommended for appointment in various departments is as under:

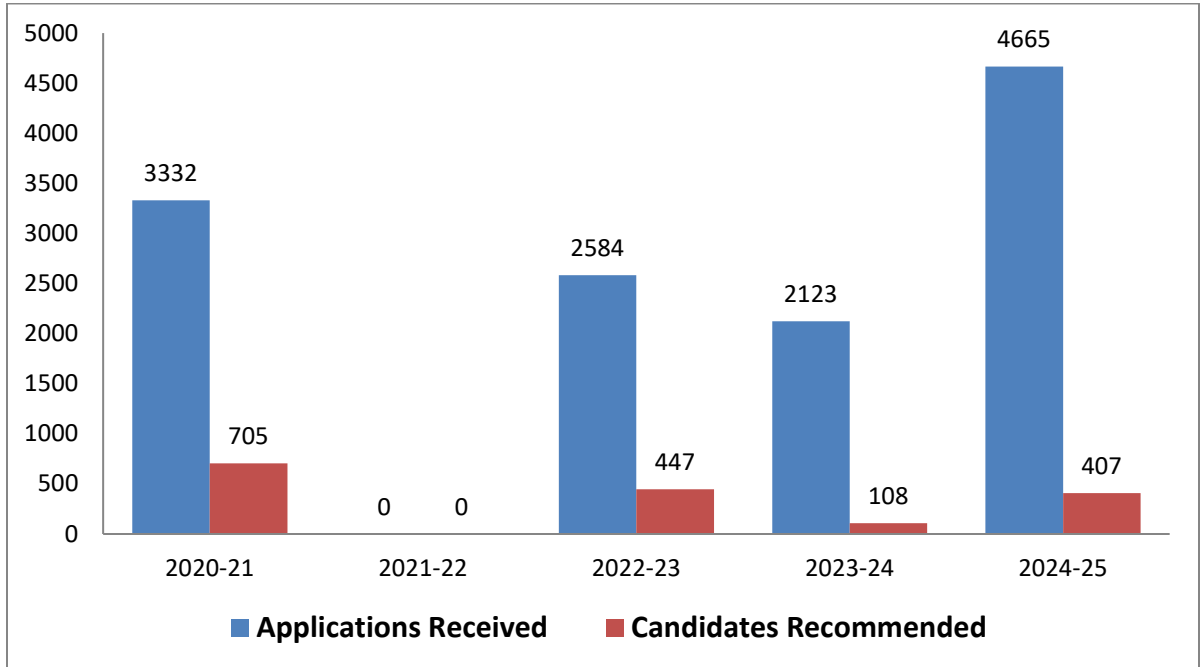

Fig. 7 Applications received and recommendations made for appointment over the past five years.

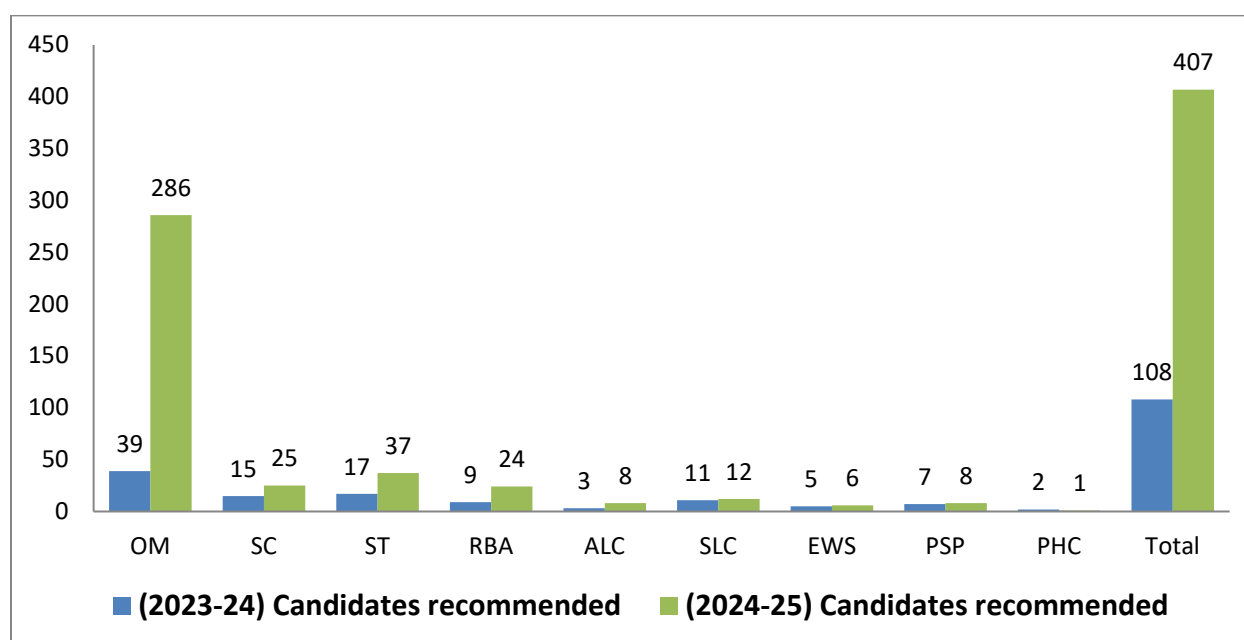

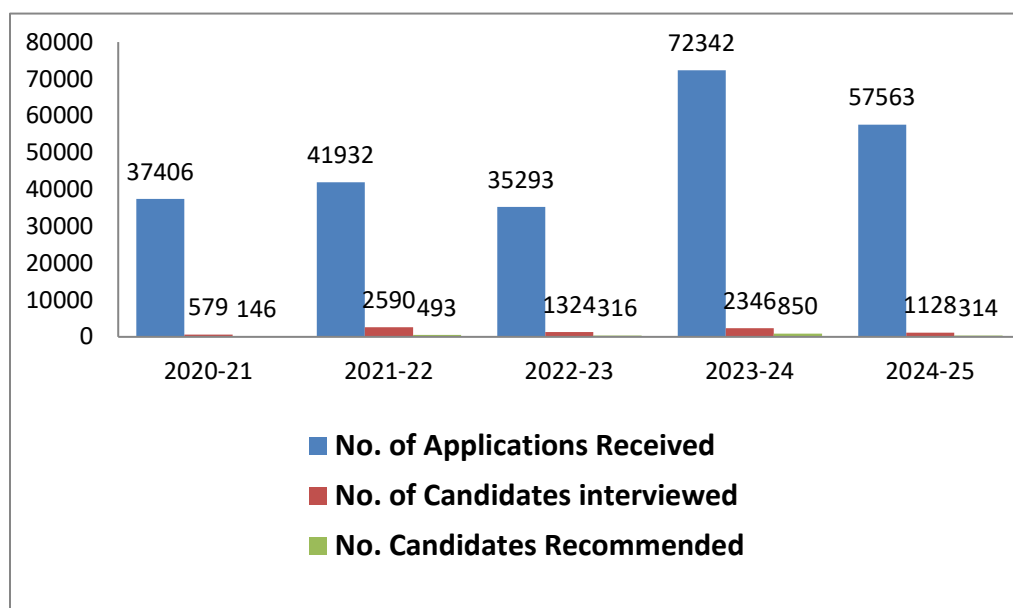

Fig. 9 Applications received and recommendations made based on the written test, followed by an interview.

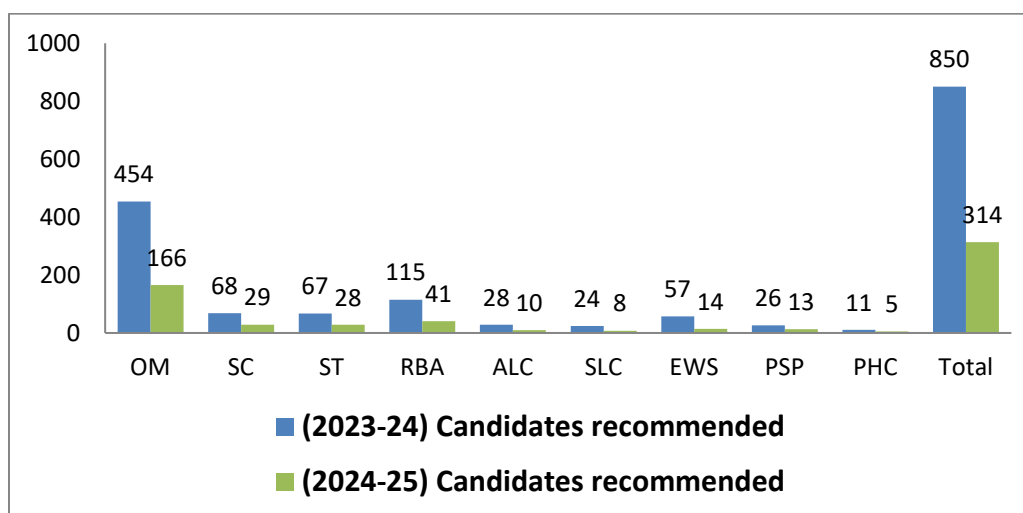


Category-wise comparison of candidates recommended during 2023-24 & 2024-25 for appointment to different services under Recruitment by Written Examination and interview.

Fig.10 Category-wise candidates recommended during the past two years.



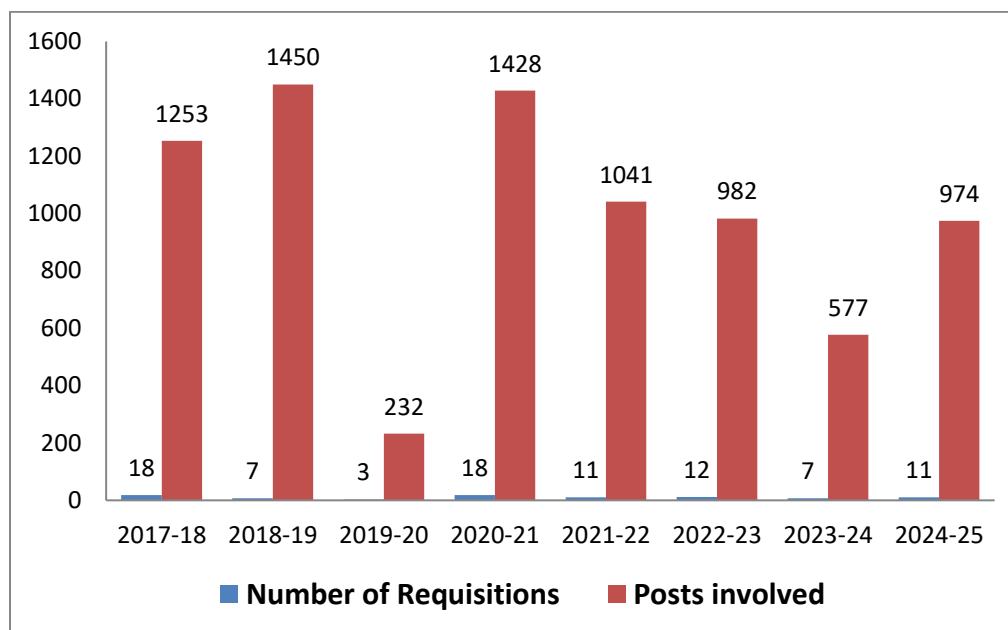

8. Promotions

11. In the Jal Shakti Department, regularization of 03 I/C Assistant Engineers as Assistant Engineers, regularization of 01 Superintendent Engineer & 01 Assistant Executive Engineer, regularization of 352 I/C AEs as AEs (Degree Holders) and regularization of 116 I/C AEs as AEs (Diploma Holders).
12. In the Hospitality and Protocol Department, 01 Assistant Director was regularized.
13. In the General Administration Department, regularization of 13 incharge Under Secretaries as Under Secretaries and regularization of 06 incharge Private Secretaries as Private Secretaries In the J&K Secretariat (Gazetted Service-II).

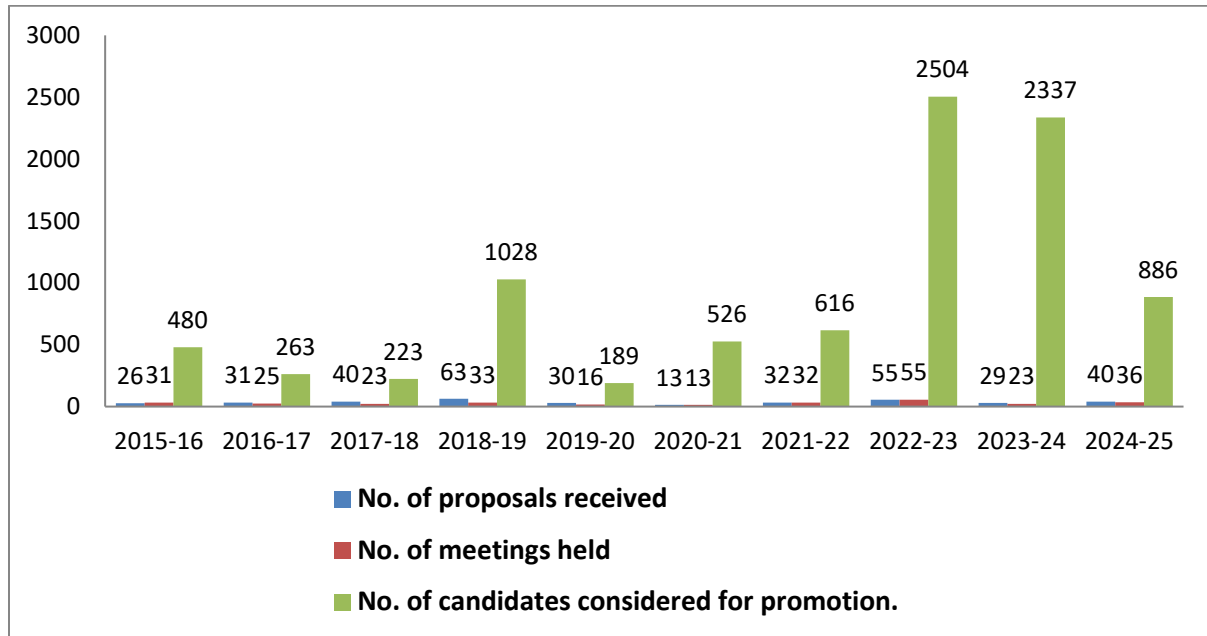

Fig.12 Proposals received, meetings held, and candidates recommended for the past 10 years

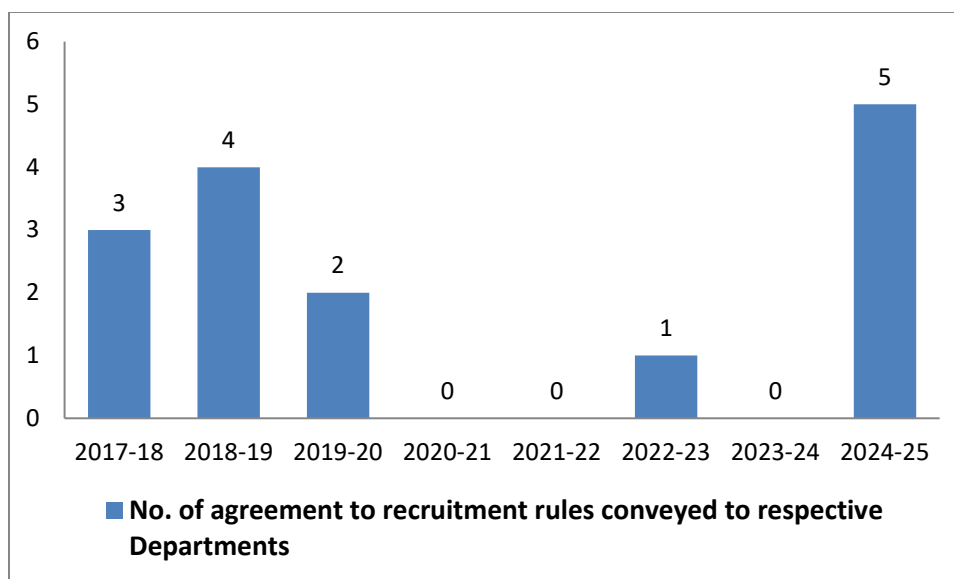

9. RECRUITMENT RULES / ADVICE RENDERED

The Recruitment Rules in respect of 02 services, of the Department of Forest, Ecology & Environment and Election Department could not be finalized on account of various reasons, including deficiencies, as indicated in appendix 8.

Five agreements of the Commission have been conveyed with regard to the draft Recruitment Rules 2024-25, as indicated in Appendix 9.

The Commission conveyed its agreement with regard to the Recruitment Rules to different departments every year.

10. MISCELLANEOUS

WRIT PETITIONS

During the year under report, comparatively, fewer writ petitions, in which the Commission is the primary respondent, were filed before the Hon'ble High Court/CAT of J&K. In most of the writ petitions of the Commission, the criteria of selection/ recruitment rules have been challenged. The Commission is regularly filing counters/ objections in the courts and monitoring the progress of cases with its Standing Counsels. Due to regular follow-up of

the Court cases, the Commission has been able to get the maximum number of court cases, particularly the Court cases of the Higher Education Department, Health and Medical Education Department and General Administration Department (KAS) decided in favour of the Commission. The names of Ex-Chairmen and Members of the J&K Public Service Commission, to the extent of records available, are given in the Appendix- 19.

Reference to vacancies and holding of meetings of Departmental Promotion Committees.

The Commission notes with concern that certain departments are not following the instructions issued by the General Administration Department from time to time, in terms of which all the departments were required to:

- (i) Refer vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota to J&K Public Service Commission and Service Selection Board by 15th of January every year (except in the case of Combined Competitive Services, which shall continue to be governed as per the existing procedure); and
- (ii) Refer the vacancies under the promotion quota to J&K Public Service

Commission/Departmental Promotion Committee, twice a year, preferably in January and July, for convening DPC meetings.

- (iii) As such, it is suggested that the Government may issue instructions to all the departments that the provisions of the SRO-166 of 2005 be implemented in letter and spirit, so that the system of promotions is streamlined and a lot of litigation be obviated, as also the process of selection against the direct recruitment quota is initiated/completed in a regular manner.

11. DIFFICULTIES AND DELAYS

(a) RECRUITMENTS:—

As already mentioned in the Annual Report of the previous years, the response of the indenting departments to the issues raised by the Commission from time to time has not always been as timely as desired. As a result, the selection/regularization process is delayed, sometimes for want of even a minor clarification.

The departments should send their formal requisitions for direct recruitment in Form-1, complete in all respects. Many

times, departments have been found to leave various columns of Form-1 incomplete. As such, some important information that should have been forthcoming from the Form-1 remains missing, which results in unnecessary delays. The Commission wishes to impress upon those heading the indenting departments of the UT of J&K that they should personally ensure that, while posts are being referred to the Commission, all the necessary information is furnished.

(b) PROMOTIONS :—

The majority of promotion cases remain pending for want of issuance of a final seniority list, annual performance reports, integrity certificates, recruitment rules and the year-wise breakup of vacancies with reference to the cause of vacancies. The Commission would like to impress upon various departments of the Government to

furnish expeditiously any information/document asked for by the Commission. The Departments, while sending the promotion proposals, should send their cases with complete documents, as required under the rules. The details of pending promotion cases with reasons for pendency are given in Appendix 6.

12. RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commission has been making recommendations in its Annual Reports highlighting the documents required for speedy disposal of cases of promotion and recruitment by examinations/interviews, but these have not been heeded by several Departments. The Commission hopes that in future these recommendations will be seriously considered by the Departments. The recommendations are as under:-

1. The proposals for regularization are not being submitted by some of the Administrative Departments in the forms as prescribed in the Government Order No. 1303-GAD of 1969 dated 28.06.1969, besides the PSC has issued circular, vide No. 1 PSC of 2016, dated 15-01-2016, where under, procedure/schedule for conducting DPC on monthly basis has been circulated among all the Departments to make the process easy. But the instructions/schedule have not been followed in letter and spirit. Keeping in view the uniformity and objectivity of DPC, the Commission has issued a revised checklist (Appendix-20) vide Order No. 01 PSC of 2019 dated

08-07-2019. The same has been forwarded to all the Administrative Departments under endorsement No. PSC/DPC/01/2016 dated 08-07-2019. Besides, a copy of the same has also been forwarded to the General Administration Department vide No. PSC/DPC/Checklist/02/2019, dated: 23.01.2019, for circulation among all the Administrative Departments with the directions to adhere to the checklist in letter & spirit while preparation/submission of DPC proposals.

The Details of DPC Proposals received/not received from the Departments during the year under report are mentioned in Appendix 7.

2. It has been observed by the Commission that some Departments submit the proposals for DPC only up to the first Level Gazetted Officer, i.e., Under Secretary, Private Secretary, etc., to the Commission. The DPCs of higher posts are being done by the Administrative Departments at their own level. It is recommended that DPC Proposals up to the Level of Additional Secretary may also be submitted to the Commission on the analogy of Finance, PWD (R&B), and

Planning Development & Monitoring Departments, etc.

3. The APRs received from various Departments are often found incomplete. Although there is a provision in the APR rules that, in case of non-availability of requisite APRs due to certain reasons, the Administrative Secretary may furnish the work and conduct certificates in lieu of APRs, with the reasons for non-availability of requisite APRs. But some of the Administrative Departments established a practice to furnish work and conduct certificates without reasons as an alternative to APRs. This practice needs to be stopped. The Administrative Department, while furnishing the proposals, should ensure that APRs are properly reviewed and accepted by the competent authority and are complete in all respects.
4. The work and conduct/Integrity certificates received from the various Departments are not signed/countersigned by the concerned Administrative Secretaries. Administrative Departments should make it sure that work and conduct/integrity certificates are duly authenticated by the concerned authorities.
5. It has been observed that after submitting the proposals, the Administrative Departments do not bother to respond to the communications regarding the deficiencies or any query regarding the proposal, which results in inordinate delay.
6. The Administrative Departments shall ensure the timely/relevant reply to queries/ Communications for the speedy disposal of DPC cases. The Departments whose cases are pending for want of clarification are mentioned in Appendix 6.
7. Some Departments, while submitting the DPC proposals to the Public Service Commission, do not adhere to the incumbency position.
8. Some of the Departments are not represented in the DPC meetings on the date fixed by the Commission. In exceptional cases, where the Departments are not in a position to attend the DPC meetings on the scheduled date due to some unavoidable circumstances, the same shall be communicated to the Commission at least two days before the scheduled date of the DPC meeting.
9. The proposal for seeking concurrence of the J&K PSC on the draft recruitment rules is being submitted incompletely by some Administrative Departments in respect of comparative statements, creation/abolition orders and concurrence of the Finance Department in case of change of nomenclature/creations of posts. In order to ensure uniformity, the Commission issued a checklist for submitting draft recruitment

rules, and the same has been forwarded to all the Departments. The Administrative Department shall ensure that all the pre-requisite documents as mentioned in the checklist (Appendix-21) are enclosed while submitting the proposal to the J&K PSC. Moreover, the Recruitment Rules of most of the Departments have neither been updated for many years nor has the sanctioned strength of the cadre/posts been defined. Updating of rules is strongly recommended.

10. The DPC clears the officers for regularization on the principle of availability of vacancies, placement and eligibility, whichever is later in accordance with the provisions of the Government. Order No.743-GAD of 2007, dated 28.06.2007. It has been found that due to the delayed placement of eligible officers against higher posts, they are put to a disadvantage. A mechanism needs to be evolved to fill up the vacant posts on a stopgap basis in accordance with rules immediately after these become available for a period of six months to avoid hardships to the officers. Moreover, the Government order dated 28-06-2007 needs to be reviewed, as it adversely affects officers who, for no plausible reason or justification, are left out and later on are deprived of the benefit of promotion, if retired. In scores of cases, the Commission has noticed that without any

justification, the Departments ignored otherwise eligible officers and juniors are placed them on higher posts. The condition of placement for regularisation needs to be reviewed to ensure fair play and justice to all.

11. The Government Instructions under Article 85 of J&K CSR provide that it is wrong in principle to appoint a Government Servant to a higher post in his own cadre/line of promotion without observing the required formalities of clearance from the Departmental Promotion Committee. However, for reasons to be recorded, the Administrative authorities cannot, without detriment to public interests, wait for formal appointments; temporary stop-gap arrangements may be made by them against such posts. In making such arrangements, the competent authorities should ensure that only such officers are appointed who fulfil all requirements for higher appointments and can stand the scrutiny of Departmental Promotion Committees. Persons so appointed shall be appointed in their own pay and grade as in charge of higher posts, and will be required to discharge the duties and responsibilities of these posts. As soon as these officers are declared by the Departmental Promotion Committee fit for appointment to higher posts without any break in stop-gap

arrangements, they will be allowed full pay and allowances of those posts, if any, drawn to be adjusted in full against the retrospective increase in pay. As per Article 85 of the J&K CSR, Own Pay & Grade (OPG) arrangement shall not last beyond 6 months. However, Officers placed in OPG continue beyond 6 months, which is a gross violation of the Art. 85 of J&K CSRs and against the spirit of the judgment of the Apex Court passed in the case titled Suraj Prakash & Others V/S State of J&K & Others.

12. Grades have been released by some Administrative Departments at the time of placement, which is a gross violation of the rules. The Administrative departments should release the grades only when the DPC/PSC recommends regularization of the services of such officers.
13. The final seniority lists need to be updated and issued regularly. Some of the Departments, while updating the seniority lists, unnecessarily show the whole seniority list as tentative, which makes otherwise final positions of the officers tentative.
14. Some Departments have adopted the practice of submitting the documents at the time of the DPC meeting. Such documents submitted at the eleventh hour are not being properly scrutinized /examined. This practice is required to be stopped, and the

procedure of submission of complete documents with the proposal needs to be followed, enabling the Commission to properly scrutinize/examine the proposal in all respects, well before the DPC meeting.

15. The Administrative Departments should adhere to the schedule for referring vacancies, at the end of the year in respect of direct recruitment quota and at the beginning and middle of the year, for promotion quota to the PSC, taking due care of quota as per recruitment rules of the service at regular intervals and avoid making piecemeal reference of vacancies and the related information. The Commission also recommends that all the Government Departments be directed to comply strictly with the directions contained in the SRO-166 dated 14.06.2005, including the timely completion of APR's, issuance and updating of seniority lists, updating of schedules to the recruitment rules as well as the nomination of Nodal officers from each department, who will be duly trained to ensure compliance with these requirements and to bring to the notice of the concerned Administrative Secretary, instance of slackness, if any, in adhering to the provisions of the SRO-166 of 2005.
16. The Syllabi of the Departmental Examinations of all Departments need to be updated and brought in tune with the

changing requirements, particularly the Computer subject should be introduced as one of the papers in every Departmental Examination. The departments are advised to prepare the revised syllabi in consultation with the Commission and also consider if some papers can be prescribed on an objective-type basis.

17. The Departments, after referring to the vacancies, do not respond to furnish the deficiencies, if pointed out. Priority response of the Administrative Departments in the matter is recommended to avoid delay in the selection process.

18. Recruitment Rules of most of the State Government Departments framed decades ago are very old, outdated, obsolete and have become redundant and require their revisions and updating to keep pace with the fast changing social, economic and technological scenario, as well as efficiency and expertise required for handling assignments of complex nature in view of the diversification and specialization in the field of governance and functioning of government organizations. It is also necessary to accommodate and incentivize diversification in the field of Education, Medical Sciences and Computer Sciences. The updating and revision of Recruitment Rules to the matching requirement of the functioning of the Government Departments

will also bring down the incidence of litigation. It is recommended that the Recruitment Rules of the Government Departments be revised /updated urgently.

19. While reviewing the Recruitment Rules, there is a need to build proper pyramids to provide reasonable vertical movement in the ladders. It cannot be uniform amongst the services, but such vertical movement can be made compatible amongst the various services.

20. While amending the Recruitment Rules, the Departments also need to consider the minimum qualification for the posts. It has been noticed that in various departments, a certain category of posts is eligible for promotion to the next level post even without the basic minimum qualification as per the existing Recruitment Rules of the concerned department.

21. Mechanism of Vigilance Clearance needs to be reviewed as the delays in submitting the Vigilance Clearance cause delays in clearance of the proposals.

22. The departments should constitute Screening Committees for considering officers for the grant of selection grade, and such proposals need not be placed before the DPC/PSC. Necessary amendments can be made in the Recruitment Rules, wherever required, to exempt the selection grade.

category of posts from the purview of the DPC/PSC.

23. The advice/recommendations tendered by the Commission need to be followed, and, in case the Government delays in acting as per its advice, the Commission should be kept informed along with the reasons thereof. In case of non-acceptance of the opinion/advice of the Commission in any case, the Government has to record reasons for non-acceptance of the same.
24. The recruitment rules for services, for which the Commission has conveyed its agreement, need to be notified, and no amendment in service rules should be made without consulting the Public Service Commission as required under section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir.
25. The Departments need to consult the Commission at the time of making appointments by transfer from one service to another, and also at the time of issuing the initial constitution, as the same invariably involves the appointments by transfer.
26. The Departments need to pursue the court cases about promotions, recruitment and departmental examinations promptly and file counter/ objections promptly so that the cases are decided on merits.

13. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Commission appreciates the cooperation extended by various educational institutions and their Officers in the matter of providing suitable accommodation for various examinations held by the Commission during the year under report.

The Commission is also grateful to examiners and experts who readily accepted the Commission's invitation and assisted in the conduct of different examinations and the selection of Officers to various posts.

The Commission also expresses its deep appreciation for the hard work and dedication displayed by its staff in the performance of their duties.

The Commission also appreciates the role of the Planning Section in the compilation and editing of the 66th Annual Report-2024-25.
