Subject: O.A./156/2026 with M.A./204/2026 titled Arif Ayoub Shah ors. vs U.T of J&K and others- Disposal of representations thereof.

Whereas, the School Education Department vide communication No. Edu-Gen/35/2024-01(7383282) dated 12.11.2024 and 05.12.2024, among others, referred Thirty-Six (36) posts of Lecturer (Urdu), with the Category wise breakup, to the J&K Public Service Commission for being filled up in accordance with the relevant rules of the Department; and,

Whereas, the J&K PSC notified these 36 posts vide notification No. 07-PSC (DR-P) of 2024 dated 09.12.2024, inter-alia, mentioning about the category-wise breakup of the posts, for inviting applications. The breakup is given as under:

Whereas, the Written Examination for the post of Lecturer (Urdu) was conducted on **05.10.2025** and in pursuance of the Rule 10(c) of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination) Rules, 2022, as amended from time to time, the Provisional Answer Key pertaining to the said examination was notified on 05.10.2025 for seeking objections from candidates within three days; and,

Whereas, the objections received in the Commission in response to the Provisional Answer Key were referred to "Experts" as per the rule 10(c); and,

Whereas, on the basis of report of the experts the Final Answer Key was issued vide notification No. PSC/Exam/S/2026/17 dated 06.02.2026; and,


Whereas, the Commission also received some representations from the candidates. However, these representations were received outside the procedure for objections given in the extant rule, and as such were disposed off through regular disposal; and,

Whereas, the applicants filed an O.A./156/2026 with M.A./204/2026 titled Arif Ayoub Shah &ors. vs U.T of J&K and others in the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal at Srinagar and Hon'ble Tribunal passed the following directions:

"... In the meanwhile, it is provided that the respondents shall consider and dispose of the representation(s) filed by the applicants reportedly not decided as on date, by passing a speaking order. Needful shall be done within a period of two weeks. The applicants are at liberty to move a representation for seeking personal hearing before the competent authority, which shall conform to the doctrine of Audi Alteram Partem; and,

Now therefore, in compliance to directions passed by the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Srinagar Bench passed in O.A./156/2026 with M.A./204/2026 titled Arif Ayoub Shah ors. vs U.T of J&K and others, the representations of the applicants were examined afresh, and the same have been found to be devoid of merit, hence rejected.
