Whereas, the School Education Department vide letter No. Edu-Gen/35/2024/35/2024-01(7383282) dated 12.11.2024 and dated 05.12.2024 referred 49 posts (OM=19, RBA=05SC=04 ST-I =05 ST-II=05 ALCMB=02 SLC=04EWS=05) of Lecturer English in School Education Department to J&K Public Service Commission for selection; and,

These posts were advertised vide Notification No. 07-PSC (DR-P) of 2024 dated 09.12.2024.

The written test was conducted on 09.11.2025 and the result thereof was declared vide Notification No. PSC/Exam/S/2025/65 dated 01.11.2025. 153 candidates were declared to have provisionally qualified the examination for viva-voce.

Whereas, the provisional Select List for the post was notified vide Notification No. 35-PSC(DR-S) of 2026 dated 18.05.2026, with a stipulation that the selection is provisional, objection if any may be submitted.

Whereas, in response to the ibid Notification, the following the representation have been received from the candidates:-

Whereas, the representations from S.No. 2 and 3, cover different issues, the objections of S. No. 1 and their consideration is given here-in-under:-

There is no provision to review


Merit: There is a stark, mathematically improbable pattern where candidates with vastly inferior written scores (e.d around 43 points) and who do not possess higher research qualifications like an M.Phil or Ph.D have been uniformly compensated with near-perfect interview marks ranging between 8:00 to 9:00 points the details is given in the application.

The Commission to kindly invoke the residual/ discretionary powers of the Commission to grant me a minor formal review of the interview evaluation sheets and the criteria utilized to award viva marks for this selection.

There are currently unfilled/ vacant posts due to candidates not having crossed the benchmark remaining in this selection cycle due to dropouts or unjoined candidates. Adjusting a highly qualified M.Phil. Candidate with 49.53 written score against an already sanctioned, vacant seat will not displace any selected candidate, nor will it cause any loss to the state exchequer.

Now, therefore, the representations mentioned hereinabove is disposed off, being devoid of any merit and are, hence, rejected.
